excluding any claims or demands arising from EFPD's own negligent acts or omissions.
Applicant shall be legally responsible for the conduct and control of both its patrons and participants when using the EFF
facilities. EFPD personnel shall not be asked, and shall not volunteer, to supervise any of Applicant's employees, students, voluntee
or patrons.
3. Applicant shall use the EFPD's facilities according to EFPD policies and administrative regulations. EFPD reserves the rig to deny, cancel, or revoke Applicant access without penalty when it is determined by EFPD, in EFPD's sole discretion, that the
Applicant fails to obey any EFPD rules or regulations, causes a nuisance, engages in inappropriate activities as prohibited by EFF policies, engages in fraudulent activities, is in violation of state or federal law, or when such action is in the best interest of EFPD.
4. Applicant shall be financially responsible for the repair and/or replacement, in the discretion of EFPD, of damaged facilities and/or equipment resulting from the Applicant's use of EFPD facilities.
5. EFPD reserves the right to call emergency medical aid for the Applicant and the Applicant's injured patrons or participan
and Applicant and/or said patron or participant accepts responsibility for any financial obligations arising from such emergency medic
aid or transportation to a medical facility.
6. This Release will not be approved unless the Applicant meets EFPD's insurance requirements, including worker
compensation coverage, in effect at the time of the request. A certificate of insurance showing EFPD as an additional insured may be
required.
Applicant expressly agrees that this Release contains significant legal waivers and indemnity provisions, which impart Applicant's legal rights, and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by, and construed under, the laws of the State Colorado. If any particular provision in this Release shall be deemed invalid, the same shall not affect the balance of this Release are the remaining provisions thereof. No provision of this Release shall be construed as a contractual waiver, express or implied, of an immunities or defenses provided by the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act, Sec. 24-10-101 and following, C.R.S., as amended, any other applicable law.
